DEFINITIONS

Awards	AESA AWARDS FOR TEAM WORK -2023
Awards Management	AESA Awards, 2023– Convener and AESA Executive committee shall be responsible for the overall conduct of the Awards.
Jury	A group of professionals appointed by AESA Executive Committee to determine the winners
Terms and conditions (“T&C” or “Terms”)	Terms and conditions governing the Awards, may be amended from time to time as required, if necessary.

PROJECT BASED AWARDS

Group 1: Projects within Pune District.

In this group the project within geographical boundaries of **Pune district**, in various categories are included. Architects & Engineers from across India can participate in this group. **Visits to selected project sites will be conducted**, and in case site visits are not conducted, the assessment shall be solely on the basis documents submitted online.

AWARD CATEGORIES:

1) RESIDENTIAL: (Maximum number of Awards - 03)

Sub categories -

a) **Single Family Home (1 Award):** Bungalow / Twin bungalows / Row House / Family House / FarmHouse.

b) **Stand-alone multi-tenement residential Building (1 Award):** Irrespective of plot size.

c) **Group Housing (1 Award):** May be mix of Single-family homes, multi-tenement apartments with other amenities with no restriction of plot size.

2) NON-RESIDENTIAL: (Maximum Number of Awards - 05)

Sub categories -

A) Institutional (1 Award)

B) Offices And Retail (1 Award)

C) Hospitality (Hotels and Resorts) (1 Award)

D) Public And Cultural Buildings (1 Award)
Museums, Airports, Auditoriums, transit facilities, etc.

E) Industrial Buildings and Campuses (1 Award)

3) OTHER TYPOLOGIES: (Maximum Number of Awards - 02)

Sub categories -

A. Infrastructure Projects (1 Award)

Bridges, Public gardens, roads, etc.

B. Building Conservation, Restoration and Adaptive Reuse (1 Award)

Group 2: Projects Outside Pune District.

This group is for projects anywhere in the world **but not within geographical boundaries of Pune district**. The applicant of the project should have a registered office in the state of Maharashtra. **No site visits shall be made by the jury.**

AWARD CATEGORIES:

A. RESIDENTIAL: (Maximum number of awards - 03)

Sub categories -

- a. **Single Family Home (1 Award):** Bungalow / Twin bungalows / Row House / Family House / FarmHouse.
- b. **Stand-alone multi-tenement Building (1 Award):** (irrespective of the plot size)
- c. **Group Housing (1 Award):** Maybe mix of Single-family home, multi-tenement apartment with other amenities with no restriction of plot size.

B. NON-RESIDENTIAL: (Maximum Number of Awards - 05)

Sub categories -

- i. **Institutional: (1 Award)**
- ii. **Offices and Retail: (1 Award)**
- iii. **Hospitality (Hotels and Resorts): (1 Award)**
- iv. **Public And Cultural Buildings: (1 Award)**
Museums, Airports, Auditoriums, transit facilities, etc.
- v. **Industrial Buildings and Campuses: (1 Award)**

C. OTHER TYPOLOGIES:(Maximum number of Awards - 02)

Sub categories -

A) Infrastructure Projects (1 award): Bridges, Public gardens, roads.

B) Building Conservation, Restoration and Adaptive Reuse(1 award)

OTHER AWARDS

YOUNG ACHIEVER's AWARD (for Architect): 1 Award

OBJECTIVE:

- To encourage good work in the initial phase of a professional career so as to motivate him/her to excel further.
- To identify promising professionals in the building industry and recognize their contribution.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA (For all Submissions)

Only the projects which have been completed (completion certificate shall be issued by the Architect in case the Occupancy certificate, from concerned authorities, is yet to be received) between **1st January, 2018 and 1st January, 2023** are eligible for participation. Projects which are not yet started/ future projects/ partially completed/ incomplete projects are not eligible for participation.

The final eligibility of the Participant will be subject to the approval of AESA Executive Committee.

Participation in the awards is subject to terms and conditions/ rules and regulations laid down here and are also available on the website www.aesapune.org

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Instructions for submitting the application (via Google Form only)

- Nomination forms to be completed on the web portal www.aesapune.org
- On successful online submission of the entry, a unique code will be generated. The participant is required to use this code for all further communications pertaining to the awards.
- Participants can nominate multiple projects within a particular Award Category, and a particular project within multiple Award Categories. However, participants need to register separate nominations for each project nominated in each AwardCategory.
- After successful online submission, the participant is required to pay an entry fee as below:
For Group 1: Projects within Pune District - Rs. 3000/- (for AESA Members) **OR**
Rs. 5000/- (for Non-AESA members)
For Group 2: Projects outside Pune District - Rs. 3000/- for all entries.

These fees shall be paid **before 15th February 2023** by Cheque / DD / electronic transfer

- **A DVD / Pen Drive of minimum 10 high resolution photographs, the A2 Panels (Min 6 and Max 10), the Presentation and the 1 minute (minimum duration) video in HD format of the project should be submitted along with the entry fee to the AESA Office by 22nd Feb 2023.**
- The procedure for online submission and evaluation is described in **Annexure below**
- The participants shall submit all the relevant data mentioned in the guidelines. On preliminary scrutiny, if there are any deficiencies noticed by the screening committee appointed by the Awards management, the same shall be conveyed by mail to the applicant **up to 27th Feb 2023**. The applicant is required to provide the compliance with **before 3rd March 2023**. In case of noncompliance, the entry shall be disqualified.

Site visits: In case, site visits could not be conducted due to any restrictions or unforeseen circumstances, the assessment shall be solely on the basis of documents submitted online.

AESA AWARDS EXHIBITION

All the entries will be allowed to be exhibited at the venue of the awards ceremony for the evening (Participants to carry A2 colored Prints of the Panels) and also online on the website **www.aesapune.org** for a period of one year from date of the Awards Ceremony. The selection of the entries to be exhibited shall be solely at the discretion of the AESA Management. By participating in the competition, the participant is understood to have consented for online exhibition for a period of one year.

TIMELINES AND RECEIPTS OF ENTRIES

- Efforts will be made to adhere to the defined timelines. However, the defined timelines are subject to change based on circumstances. Awards Management shall not be held accountable / liable for any disruptions / interruptions or cancellation of the Awards or its ceremony or any part of its processes on account of any factors beyond its control.
- Last date for receiving completed Submission forms, along with supporting documents is 23.50.59 hours, Indian Standard Time on **22nd Feb.2023**.
- Date of the **Awards Ceremony** is **17th March 2023**
- Receipt of application forms after the last date of submission, may be permitted only at the discretion of the Awards Management. Such extension granted if any shall be applicable to all participants and shall be conveyed to all AESA members in advance.

AESA Awards Management will not be responsible for application forms that could not be submitted due to any issues in connectivity or communication on account of internet failure.

SHORT LISTING PROCEDURE AND DETERMINATION OF WINNERS

The procedure and evaluation criteria shall be as per the enclosed annexure.

SUBMITTALS:

1. Certificate(s) of Educational Qualifications.
2. Certificates of Merit previously obtained (if any).
3. Previous Work Experience Certificates.
4. Certificate of Professional Registration.
5. Design portfolio of at least 04 Projects consisting of: (for each project)
 - a. A Design Brief and Design Concept
 - b. Site Analysis
 - c. Set of Presentation Drawings,
 - d. Set of Working Drawings.
 - e. Specifications and BOQ.
 - f. Actual photographs during and on completion of project.
 - g. Approved Plans.
 - h. Client's Feedback letter.
 - i. If the architect is associated with a firm/member of family who is a senior professional, then a letter stating that the work being submitted is an independent effort wholly handled by the competitor.

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
